The Tetrad of Conditions

1. A wholesome mental state with sense-object arises dependent on a wholesome mental state with sense-object by root condition. (1)

An unwholesome mental state with sense-object arises dependent on an unwholesome mental state with sense-object by root condition. (1)

An indeterminate mental state with sense-object arises dependent on an indeterminate mental state with sense-object by root condition. (1) (Abbreviated.)

2. By way of root three, by way of object three... etc. by way of non-disappearance three (abbreviated. The section on the conascence also... etc. the associated section also is similar to the section on the dependent).

Root and Object Conditions

3. A wholesome mental state with sense-object is a condition for a wholesome mental state with sense-object by way of root condition. (1)

35. An unwholesome clinging mental state arises dependent on an unwholesome clinging mental state by root condition (in brief).

By way of root one, by way of object one... etc. by way of non-disappearance one (the clinging group should be expanded).

The triad of wholesome with the clinging group is finished.
